CLD is on the cusp of significant expansion. By 2024, we will grow the number of students we serve to 6,500 each year and begin providing our unique programs and services at satellite locations throughout Central Indiana. The support of new donors and partners like you from our community is critical to achieving our goal.

\$4.5M capacity building & program expansion

- >> Establish satellite locations in high crime, low income areas across Central Indiana
