I'll be honest: I want to envision—I want us all to envision—not just a "brighter" future for the Black youth of this city, but a blinding one. I mean knock-you-out, burn-your-retinas if you look directly at it, solar eclipse-level bright future. A future in which educators and elected officials travel here in great numbers to learn how CLD and the City of Indianapolis transformed first the educational trajectory and then the whole life trajectory of a generation of Black youth, and how that transformation then transformed our city at large. A future in which Indianapolis is as well-known for its approach to racial equity as it

is for its 500-mile race. A future in which Indianapolis is known for having higher high school graduation rates for Black students than any other city in the Midwest, where Black college students seek out internships because they've heard how many opportunities can be found here.
