
CLD programs cost us **\$525 per participant**, families are asked to pay \$25 on average. This means CLD has to raise

As a charitable organization committed to offering youth preeminent program experiences that help nurture talent, we are committed to offering youth and families high-quality, high-impact learning experiences at nominal cost to families. For example, our outstanding, longstanding leadership program, Self-Discovery/Career Exploration, costs our organization roughly \$525 per participant; however, families only pay \$25 per person to participate in this substantive, highly impactful 13-week learning experience.
